Venue Information

Entry Fee

Entry fees apply at every ground throughout the Pre-Season Club Championship with funds the raised being used to help cover the cost of referees (in the vicinity of \$3,000) for the day.

As Dalton Park is an open access venue without a gate entrance we ask that all Team Managers collect \$2 per player & pay this to Peninsula Power Representative located inside the Clubhouse prior to your team taking the field.

AJ Kelly Park entry is via the front gate only. An entry fee of \$2 per person, over age of 12 years of age, will be charged on entrance for all Junior games.

An entry fee of \$5 per person, over the age of 12 years of age will be charged for the Senior games.

Car Parking

Dalton Park has three carparks available accessible via Bell Street & Maine Road Clontarf. Please do not obstruct the Emergency Vehicle access gates.

AJ Kelly Park has one carpark available & street parking in surrounding streets. Please not park across private driveways within the venue carpark. Please do not obstruct the Emergency Vehicle access gates.

COVID-19 Requirements

Check-In via QR Codes is still mandatory for ALL visitors to Dalton Park & AJ Kelly Park.

As Dalton Park is an 'open space' without a gate entrance we will have COVID-19 Officers walking around the venue with the QR Codes. Please assist our Volunteers & ensure you scan & sign in when approached.

On entrance to AJ Kelly Park you will be asked to scan & sign in prior to be allowed access to the venue.

Hand sanitising stations are located around both venues. Please ensure you practice good hand hygiene & utilise the sanitising stations.

Please be cognisant of the fact that CLUB VOLUNTEERS will be working on the entry gate, so we ask that members of ALL clubs remain respectful and polite at all times.

Food Service

Dalton Park canteen will be open from 8am serving all day until completion of the tournament games.

There will also be a Coffee Van located between Field 1 & Field 2 serving Hot Beverages

AJ Kelly Park canteen will be open from 1.30pm serving until the completion of the last Senior Men game at 9.30pm. If you are looking for lunch, snacks or dinner items please visit our canteen.

Public Amenities

Dalton Park has toilets located inside the Clubhouse building. Access is via corridor beside the canteen.

Dalton Park also has public toilets located in the Bell Street carpark.

AJ Kelly Park has toilets located outside on ground level and also upstairs in the bar area which will be accessible once the bar is open.
